Endicott Clay Products, a century-old brick manufacturer from the US, renowned for its unique "Ironspot" clays, has long worked at the intersection of traditional materials and cutting-edge architectural projects.

With a strong focus on commercial construction and a client base that includes architects, contractors and large institutions, the company recognized the need to evolve its digital offering to match the modern design workflow.

This is where ARCHITEXTURES came in.

Outdated visualization processes

While Endicott had been ahead of the curve by digitizing their bricks as BIM models as early as 2009, the visualization tools available to them were cumbersome and disconnected from the architect's day-to-day tools.

Endicott needed:

- A way to let architects experiment and visualize blends in real-time
- A web-based, Revit-compatible tool to minimize friction
- A cost-saving solution to reduce unnecessary sample mockups
- Something that could scale across teams and clients with ease

Reduced sample waste


Because users can visualize blends before ordering samples, the number of physical mockups has dropped, saving both time and shipping costs.










Looking ahead
